

Get a ClipperSM card to pay your transit fares. It's free (for now).

The Clipper card is a universal fare card that can be used to pay your transit fares on **AC Transit, BART, Caltrain, Golden Gate Transit & Ferry and Muni**. Just load money on the card and scan your card to pay your fare at the turnstile. Your transit fare will automatically be deducted from the value on your card.

The \$5 fee for getting a Clipper card is being waived starting June 16.

This offer is available for a limited time and may be subject to change without notice.

You can load your TransBen voucher (Commuter Check) on the Clipper card at Walgreens or at other participating retail locations.

There are two kinds of funds you can load on your card. You can load “transit specific” funds, such as a BART high value ticket, or a MUNI monthly pass on the card. Or, you can load money on your card as “e-cash”. This money can be used at any participating transit agency.

What if I have a TransLink Card?

If you have a TransLink card, you can keep using your TransLink card for now. TransLink will fully transition to Clipper at a later date. At that time, you will have to sign up for a Clipper card. You might want to get it now, while it's free.

What if I have a BART EZ Rider Card?

If you currently use an EZ Rider card to pay for transit, your card will still work. However, it will stop working to pay for transit fares at a future date. At that time, you will have to sign up for a Clipper card. You might want to get it now, while it's free.

You will be able to use your EZ Rider card to pay for parking at BART until Clipper begins to offer this service.
