

Get a ClipperSM card to pay your transit fares. It's free (for now).

The Clipper card is a universal fare card that can be used to pay transit fares on AC Transit, BART, Caltrain, Golden Gate Transit & Ferry, Muni, and SamTrans. Load money on the card and then tag it at the turnstile or on the bus. Transit fares will automatically be deducted from the card.

The \$5 fee for getting a Clipper card is currently being waived.

This offer is available for a limited time and may be subject to change without notice. You can load your TransBen voucher (Commuter Check) on your Clipper card at Walgreens or at other participating retail locations.

There are two kinds of funds which you can load on your card. You can load "transit specific" funds, such as a BART high value ticket, or a MUNI monthly pass on the card. Or, you can load money on your card as "e-cash". This money can be used at any participating transit agency.

Should I register my card?

If you register your card, you can get it replaced if it is lost, stolen, or damaged. Also, you will be able to get a cash refund (\$5.00 processing fee) if you no longer need your card.

What if I have a TransLink Card?

If you have a TransLink card, you can keep using your TransLink card for now. TransLink will fully transition to Clipper card at a later date. At that time, you will need to sign up for Clipper card. You might want to do it now while it's free.

What if I have a BART EZ Rider Card?

The EZ Rider card can no longer be used to pay for transit fares; however, you can still use it to pay for parking at BART stations.

Can I use my Clipper card to pay for parking at BART stations?

At this time, you can use either a BART EZ Rider card or a Clipper card to pay for parking at BART stations.
